1. Purpose of this Form

This form is to be used to apply for a licence that would enable the applicant to generate electricity or provide ancillary services for sale through the Independent Electricity System Operator ("IESO") administered markets or directly to another person. Standard Offer Program generators should use the licence application form specified for Standard Offer Program generators, which can be found on the Board's website at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca.

This form is in a writeable PDF format. The applicant must either:

- type answers to all questions, print two copies and sign both copies; or
- print a copy of the form, clearly print answers to all questions, make a copy and sign both copies.

The project will have two project owned substations, each with one project 34.5 kV to 230 kV transformer. with associated low and high side circuit breakers and protective relays. There are three 230 kV line segments totaling about 34 km connecting two project substations to the Ontario Grid at HONI's Chatham SS.

A small fenced area just outside Chatham SS will contain the required IESO revenue meter which will meter the energy delivered to the grid from the entire project.
